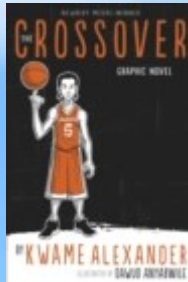

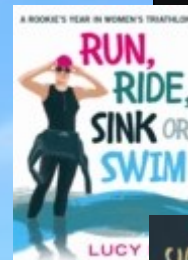
Josh and Jordan are kings of the basketball court, but this graphic novel is about family and rap music too.

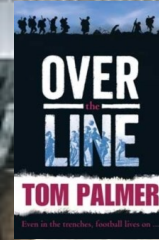


A Young Adult story in verse. Lilly is being bullied but finds a way of coping through a new found love of boxing. A story of hope and resilience.

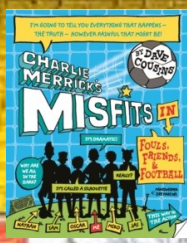


Part of the Run series about the different members of an elite running team.

Inspired by the true story of Pickles and the time the World Cup went missing.



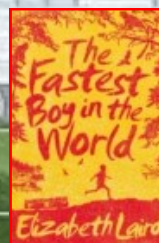
Set in World War I, this short read tells the story of the Flanders Cup and Jack's dream of playing for England
