Oxbridge Talk

Rossett Sixth Form is linked to St Catharine's College at Cambridge University and Brasenose College at Oxford University. We are in regular correspondence with the staff at these colleges who share with us any upcoming events and workshops that they think our students would benefit from. As part of our links with these colleges, a group of Year 12 students were invited to attend a workshop for local schools delivered by staff from Oxford and Cambridge. This workshop looked at the application process to both universities. The students really enjoyed the event, and they received lots of useful guidance and advice. It was also a brilliant opportunity for our students to meet current Oxbridge students and learn more about university life.

UCAS and progression update

Well done to all of the Year 13 students who have now successfully submitted their university applications. The vast majority of students have already had a number of offers back from their chosen destinations and can now focus on making sure they get the grades to meet the entry requirements. The universities have until 18th May to respond to all offers. Once all offers are in, students can start to make decisions about firm and insurance places.

Personal Development update

Last half term I wrote to you about our Personal Development Programme undergoing some exciting changes following student voice feedback. This half term both Year 12 and Year 13 students have been focussing on Citizenship. Year 12 students have been focussing on: women's rights, violence against women, conspiracy, extremism and social media and the Law. Year 13 have been looking at: voting at 18, political change and the criminal justice system.

Next half term Year 12 will be looking at 'Getting Ready for Life Post 18', with sessions on degree apprenticeships, employment, gap years and personal finance. Year 13 will have their final Personal Development sessions before the commencement of study leave, focussing on: living away from home, student finance and cooking quick, easy and nutritious meals.

Comic Relief

We are really proud of all of the fundraising work that happens at Rossett Sixth Form. In addition to raising funds for our chosen Sixth Form charities, on 17th March, students came to school in non-uniform and fancy dress and took part in a hugely popular zorbing event to raise money for Comic Relief.
