## Year 7 to Year 10 Trip to Flamingo Land

We are delighted to announce the details of a new summer rewards trip taking place at the end of term for Year 7 to Year 10. This is to recognise and celebrate the students who demonstrate our Rossett values and to provide an exciting experience for our school community.

## Dates and Timinas:

Year 7 and Year 8 – Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> July Year 9 and Year 10 – Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> July

Flamingo Land has a wide variety of theme park rides, an award-winning zoo and various other shows and attractions. It promises to be an exciting day out.

All students in Year 7 to 10 are currently eligible for the trip as we begin the new term. Students who opt not to attend the trip will be required to attend school as normal, wearing full school uniform.

The cost of the trip is £42, which can be paid in three instalments. This includes entry to Flamingo Land (usually £52 on the gate for a single ticket) and return coach travel. If you would like your child to take part in this trip, the first payment of £15 is required on SCOPAY by 5<sup>th</sup> May. Further payments will be due on 1<sup>st</sup> June and 1<sup>st</sup> July. Once payment has been made it is non-refundable as coaches will be booked.

## Further details and Expectations:

Buses will depart to Flamingo Land at 9:00am. Students will be required in school at the normal time and we anticipate that both trips will arrive back at school at approximately 5.00pm. Students that usually use school transport for their journey home will be required to make their own arrangements home from Rossett School on the day of the trip.

Students on the trip will be representing Rossett School. We expect all students to conduct themselves in a mature manner, in line with our school values.

Students are expected to make their own arrangements for lunch. They are able to bring a packed lunch or there will be facilities to purchase lunch on site. Please note that students who receive free school lunches will be provided with a free packed lunch.

We reserve the right to remove any student's place on the trip for consistent or significant breaches of the Behaviour Policy.

Students are not required to wear school uniform and should dress appropriately, wearing clothing suitable for a full day outdoors in typical July weather.

## Next steps:

- Please make the first payment of £15 by 5<sup>th</sup> May. Further payments are due on 1<sup>st</sup> June and 1<sup>st</sup> July. You may also pay in full. Note that the first payment is required by 5<sup>th</sup> May to ensure your child's place on the trip.
- Complete Parental consent and medical details form.
- If your child would prefer not to attend this trip, they should attend school as normal in their school uniform. Students will attend an adjusted timetable that will be provided to them on the day during registration.

We very much look forward to this trip and recognising the considerable efforts students have made this academic year.
