# The deadline for the receipt of the Autumn 2023 term Bursary application is Friday 30 September 2023.

For a student to be eligible for consideration for a 16 – 19 Bursary, they must meet one or more of the following criteria:

- 1. The student or sibling is already registered for free school meals at the school
- 2. The household income less than £25,000
- 3. The student is living independently with an income of less than £25,000

The value of the award will vary dependent on the assessment of income and type of award made.
