Marrick Priory Trip – January/February 2019

Your child has expressed an interest in attending a trip to Marrick Priory in January/February 2019. Marrick Priory is a historic 12th century medieval building that was developed in the 1970s into an Outdoor Education and Residential Centre. It is situated in Swaledale, near Richmond, in the heart of the beautiful Yorkshire Dales National Park.

The Priory is licensed to provide a wide range of adventurous activities and participants will have the opportunity to try climbing, abseiling, orienteering, low and high ropes courses and team building exercises. In the evening, we will also experience night navigation in preparation for those students wishing to take part in the Duke of Edinburgh Award, which will be offered in Year 9.

For the x half of the year, the trip will run from Friday 25 January to Saturday 26 January. For the y half of the year, the trip will run from Friday 1 February to Saturday 2 February. Students will leave school at 11am on the Friday and return to school by 6pm on the Saturday. Students will travel to/from the Priory from school by coach.

The cost of the trip is £90 which includes travel, all activities, accommodation and meals. Participants will need to bring a packed lunch on the Friday which they will eat on their arrival at the site. All specialist equipment is provided and students will need to bring warm, comfortable outdoor clothing. A full list will be provided. Students may also bring up to £5 to spend at the tuck shop.

To confirm your interest, please complete the attached form and return to the Finance Office by Friday 12 October 2018, with a deposit of $\pounds 30$. Another $\pounds 30$ should be paid by Friday 16 November, with the remainder, $\pounds 30$, due by Friday 14 December.

There are a limited number of places available for each trip as the Priory can only accommodate 40 students and 6 members of staff. I will allocate places on a first come first served basis and will keep a small waiting list.

I hope your child enjoys this opportunity to experience a range of adventurous outdoor activities.
