Dear Parents/Carers

As the 2019 exam season draws closer, we will be running a number of additional activities in order to best support your child in the preparation for their examinations.

## Form Time Study Sessions

Starting the week commencing 18<sup>th</sup> March, Year 11 students will have the opportunity to study towards their exams during form time on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. For some students this will be private study in their normal tutor groups. For other students, we will be running targeted sessions in a variety of subjects including: English, Maths, Science, Geography, History, French, Spanish, Physical Education, Business Studies, Drama, Art, Food, Textiles and Computer Science.

We will be notifying students of which sessions they will be going to on Monday morning. Where students are completing private study during form time, we would ask that the students come prepared with materials to revise from.

## 'Walking and Talking' Mock Exams

We will also be running some 'walking and talking' mock exams in the core subjects (English, Maths and Science) and in Geography and History. 'Walking and Talking' Mocks are an opportunity for the students to experience sitting a practice paper in an official examination setting, but with the benefit of having subject specialists to talk through each question and to give the students hints and tips as to the answers, exam technique and timing. The dates and timing of these sessions is outlined in the table below:
