How to Prepare

- Students will require full mathematical exam equipment of two pens, a sharp pencil, an eraser, a ruler, a protractor and a pair of compasses (equipment is available to purchase from the upstairs Maths Office).
- To prepare for the assessment, students should work through the supporting material attached on Show My Homework (SMHW). Subject teachers will ensure that all students have access to Hegarty Maths before the half-term break (although most students should already be familiar with this site).

Year 7 Art

Assessment/Exam Content: Observational Drawing

How to prepare

Assessment details

Students will have a brief conversation with their class teacher based on free time activities and likes and dislikes. Students must be able to discuss and write about these topics to achieve Foundation and Developing. In order to access Secure students must be able to use different persons of the verb and for Excellence students must use a future tense. Students should also be able to ask the teacher questions in the target language.

The written paper will be **60 minutes** and students will be expected to write in detail about free time activities, their likes and dislikes using different persons of the verb and a future tense. Students should aim to use lots of opinion phrases.

How to prepare

Assessment Information
