1. Emojis. Students to create messages through emojis giving safer Internet messages

2. A tweet from the Rossett Account to encourage all of the followers to spread the word re. safer internet day

3. Wall of change

SC to man a wall, where students can post “Links” on paper as to how they want to see a safer internet
