Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to inform you of our biennial sponsored walk which will take place on Friday 27th June 2025. This year's theme will be Rossett Red where we are asking all students to wear their Rossett PE red polo shirt and/or Rossett PE hooded top.

This walk has been a popular event in the school calendar for over thirty years. This year, we have changed our route following consultation with colleagues and students and we are very excited about this! The new route is 12km which takes us into the local countryside, past Harlow Carr Gardens and through Valley Gardens, with students following pedestrian paths and public right of ways through fields. The route will be extensively marshalled and the walkers supervised to ensure the venture takes place as safely as possible.
