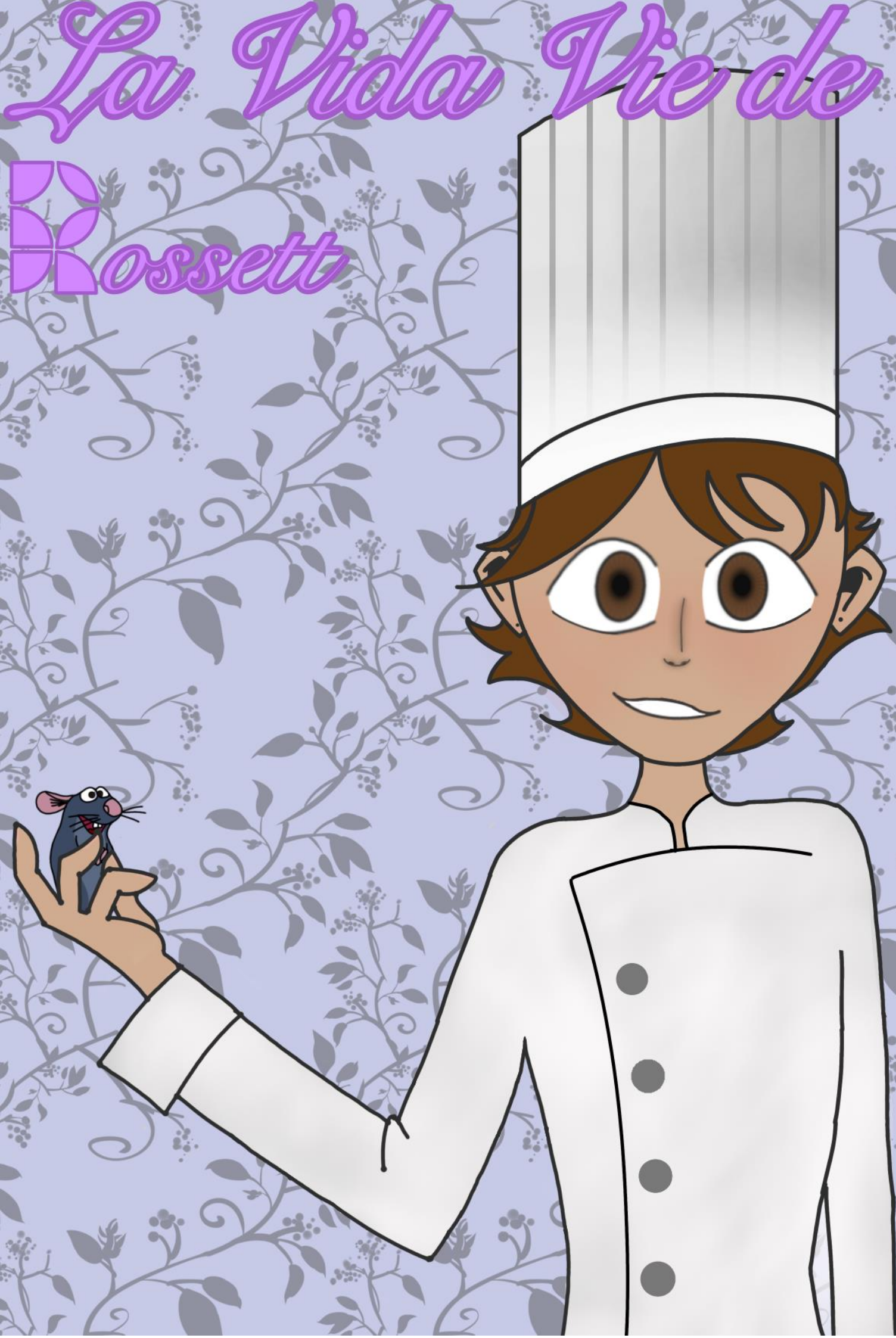

Coco Chanel

Coco Chanel was born on the 19th August 1883 in Samur, France and died on the 10th January 1971, making her 87 years old.



Her real name was Gabrielle. She was a French designer and business woman. She is the only fashion designer listed on time magazines list of the 100 most influential people of the 20th century.



Chanel extended her influence beyond couture clothing into jewellery, handbags, and fragrance. Her signature scent; Chanel no.5 has become an iconic product and Chanel herself designed the interlocked cc monogram, which has been used since the 1920s.

Spanish fashion designer

Adolfo Domínguez

He was born on the 14th May 1950, making him 74 years old. He won the National Designer prize in 2014.



He took over his fathers fashion boutique in Ourense in the early 1970s. He made a big jump in 1981 and gave a presentation of his work, in Madrid.

He became the first Spanish designer to open his own brand name store in Madrid, which grew into a chain of outlets across Spain and abroad.

The equestrian events at the 2024 Summer Olympics in Paris were run from 27 July to 6 August at the Palace of Versailles, featuring 200 riders across three disciplines for both individual and team competitions, namely dressage, eventing, and jumping. Men and women compete together on equal terms.

The best ever French riders were called Morgan Barbançon riding Sir Donner hall II but the most famous horse rider was François Robichon de la Guérinière.

Versailles is a beautiful horse riding palace which is renowned for its parfait horse riding performances.

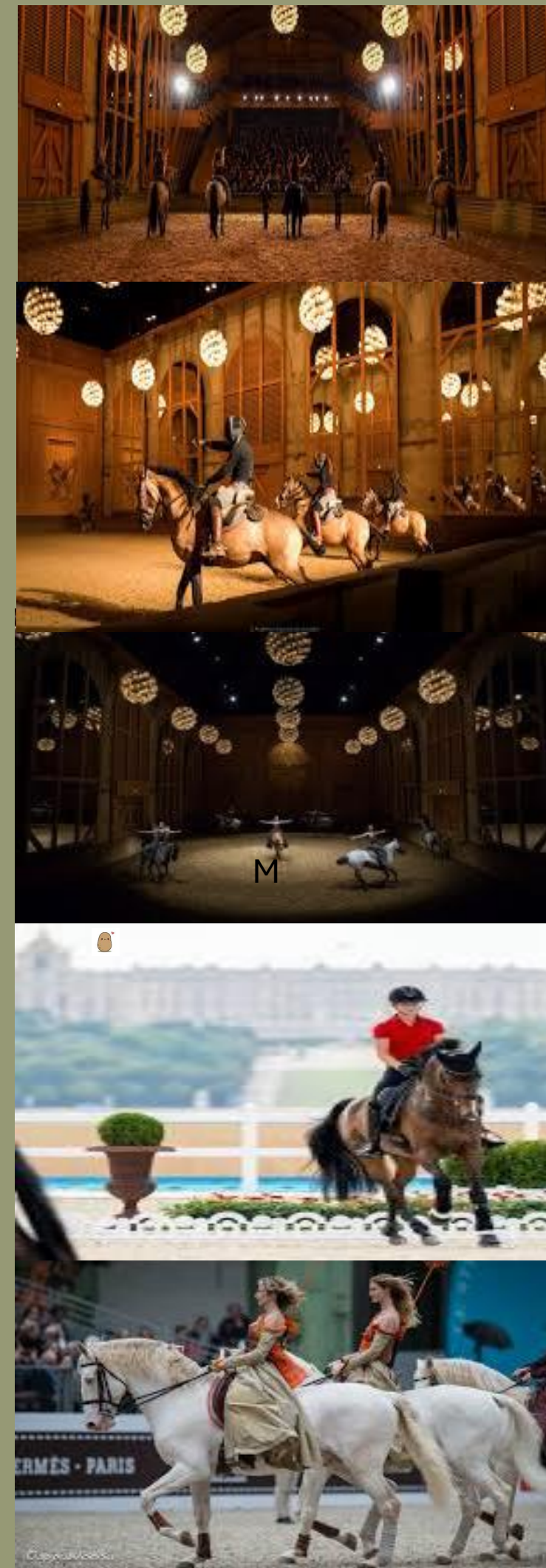
The Versailles great and small stables were commissioned by Louis XIV to accommodate the household's horses and became the greatest royal construction project for housing horses ever undertaken. These stables are still used today for the Versailles equestrian horse show.

The main types of horse breed at Versailles are the white Lusitanians, the favourite breed of Louis XIV, the sun king.

housed an overwhelming number of over 2,000 horses. A portion of the horses were then moved to other royal residences or in other locations in Versailles.¹⁰

The show at Versailles is approximately 1 hour long and is followed by a free tour of the Grande Écurie.

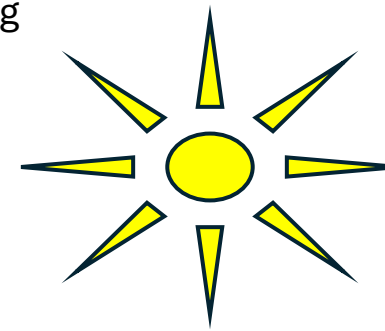

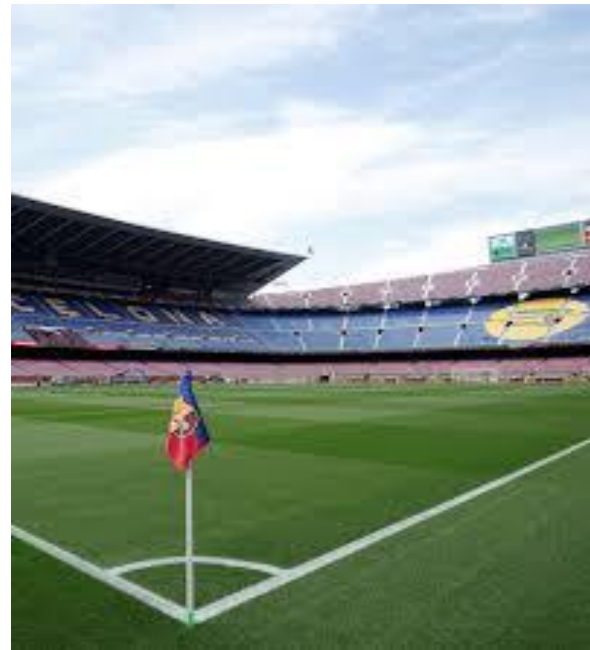

Traditionally speaking, **Spanish children don't receive their Christmas gifts until the 6th** of January (Day of the Epiphany), when The Three Kings (Los Reyes Magos) travel all over the country delivering presents.

Nowadays, more and more families in Spain are welcoming Santa Claus to their houses and starting to [exchange gifts on Christmas Day](#) as well.

However, that doesn't mean they're forgetting about Three Kings' Day (Día de Los Reyes Magos). Quite the opposite! As a matter of fact, this day remains the traditional gift-giving day in Spain

Roscón de Reyes



Roscón de Reyes is a traditional Spanish sweet bread typically enjoyed on Epiphany, or Three Kings' Day, on January 6th. It is shaped like a ring and often decorated with candied fruits and a dusting of sugar, resembling a crown. The bread can be filled with whipped cream, chocolate, or other sweet fillings, and sometimes contains small surprises or figurines hidden inside.

Receta de Roscón de Reyes:

Mezcla 500g de harina, 100g de azúcar, 2 huevos, 100g de mantequilla, 20g de levadura, y un poco de agua y ralladura de naranja hasta obtener una masa homogénea.

1. Deja reposar la masa hasta que doble su tamaño.

2. Forma un anillo con la masa, decora con frutas escarchadas y hornea a 180°C durante 20-25 minutos.

3. Una vez horneado, rellena con nata o chocolate y decora con azúcar.

El día de los muertos



The day of the Dead, or Día de los Muertos, is a vibrant Mexican holiday that honors deceased loved ones, not with mourning, but with celebration and remembrance. It's a multi-day festival, typically celebrated on November 1 and 2, that blends pre-Hispanic Mesoamerican traditions with Christian customs. The holiday is rooted in ancient Aztec beliefs about the return of souls, and it's a time for families to welcome back their loved ones, often through the creation of altars called ofrendas

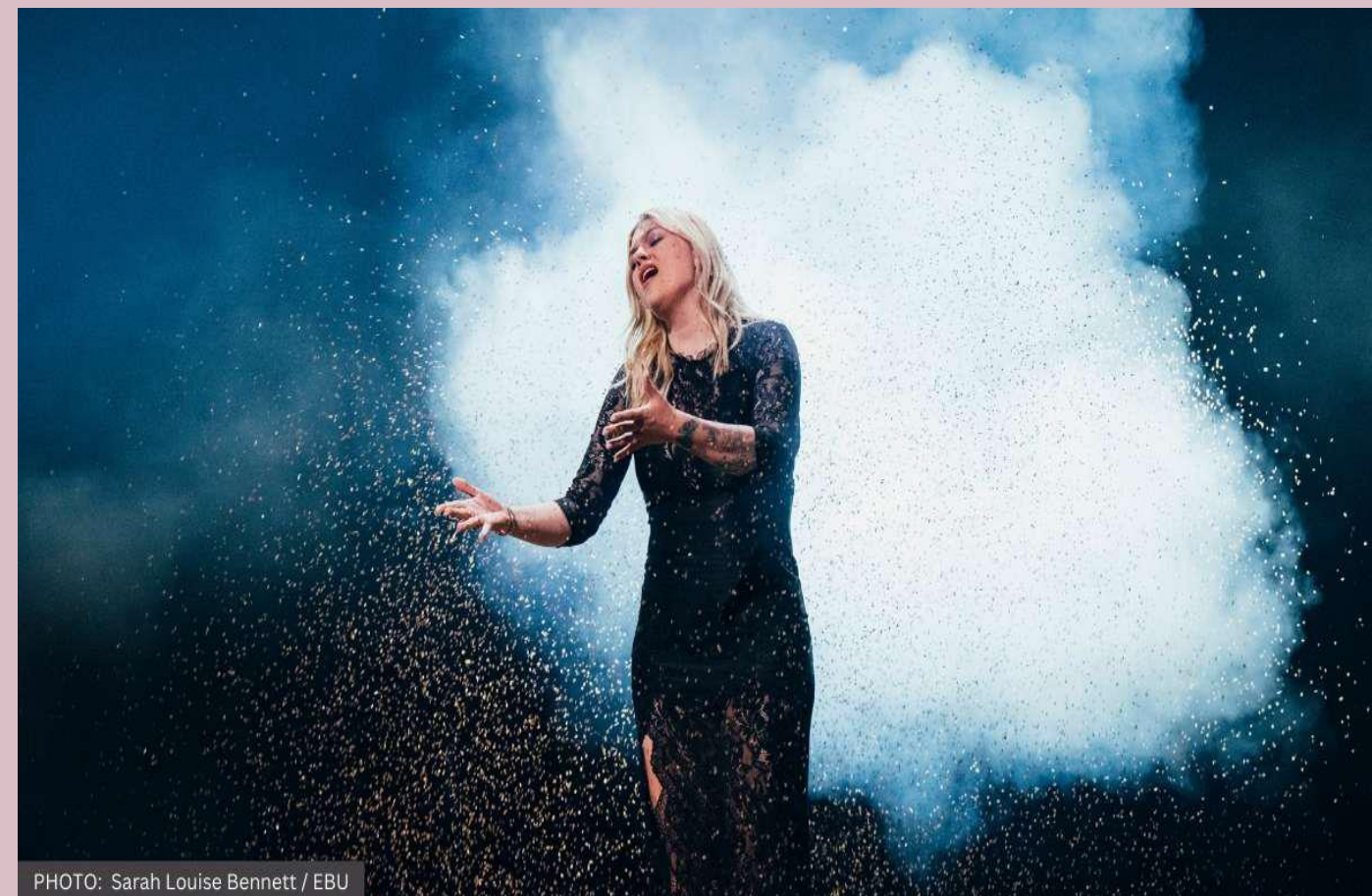
EUROVISION 2025 Spain and France

Paella's fame stems from its status as a social dish and a symbol of Spanish cuisine, particularly in Valencia. It's a dish enjoyed at family gatherings, festivals and even outdoor picnics, fostering a sense of community and celebration. Additionally, paella's unique flavours, vibrant colours and the tradition of cooking it over an open flame contribute to its enduring popularity.

What is in a paella?

Paella is a Spanish rice dish that originated in Valencia. It is traditionally cooked in a wide, shallow pan called a paellera, and is known for its flavourful combination of rice, saffron, vegetables, and meat or seafood. The name "paella" actually refers to the pan itself, not the dish.
