Years 9 & 10 Rewards Trips to Xscape or the Great Yorkshire Show on Wednesday 15th July

We are excited to share the details of our Summer Rewards Trips for students in Years 9 and 10. These trips are a celebration of students who consistently demonstrate our Rossett values and contribute positively to our school community.

Option 1 – Xscape Yorkshire

Xscape Yorkshire is an indoor leisure and entertainment complex located in Castleford.

- Cost: **£15** (includes return coach travel) payable on Arbor – please note that this is a voluntary contribution. If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip may not be able to go ahead.
- If students wish to take part in any activities, bookings must be made at your own expense. Please ensure that any activities are completed in good time so students can return to the bus promptly at the agreed departure time.
- Full payment required by 19th June 2026.

Please note: once payment is made, it is non-refundable as travel arrangements will be confirmed.

Key Details:

- Depart from Rossett at 9.00am; arrive back at school around 5.00pm.
- Students should arrive at school at the usual time.
- Students must arrange their own transport home from school at the end of the day.
- Lunch: bring a packed lunch or purchase on-site. Free school meal students will be provided with a packed lunch.
- Non-uniform day - students should wear comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing.
- Please note that although staff members will be present throughout the trip and a central meeting point will be clearly communicated to students should they need assistance, students will not be supervised at all times and will be permitted to move around the venue independently.

Option 2 – Great Yorkshire Show

The Great Yorkshire Show is a popular agricultural event in Harrogate, celebrating farming, food, and the countryside. It offers an educational, fun-filled day featuring over 8,500 animals, main ring entertainment, machinery displays, and interactive zones.

- Cost: **£10** (includes entry ticket) payable on Arbor – please note that this is a voluntary contribution. If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip may not be able to go ahead.
- Full payment required by 19th June 2026.
