

GCSE Philosophy and Ethics

Exam Structure: At Rossett, we do the AQA Religious Studies specification. The GCSE is split into two exams or components.

Philosophy (Component 1): The study of religious beliefs, teachings and practices

What is assessed?

Beliefs and practices from Christianity and Buddhism.

How is it assessed?

Written exam: 1 hour 45 minutes
96 marks (plus 5 marks for SPaG)
50% of GCSE

Ethics (Component 2): Thematic studies

What is assessed?

- Theme B – Religion and life
- Theme D – Peace and conflict
- Theme E – Crime and punishment.
- Theme F – Human rights and social justice.

How is it assessed?

Written exam: 1 hour 45 minutes
96 marks (plus 5 for SPaG)
50% of GCSE

Exam technique

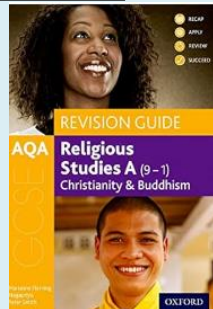
Each section has a common structure of one five-part question of 1, 2, 4, 5, 12 marks. Each theme is marked out of 24.
