**This course aims to** use collage and acrylic to build up texture, depth and interest in your work.

You will learn how to apply collage and paint to gain balance and rhythm and develop an understanding of colour, line, and perspective.

This course is for beginners or advanced learners who want to build their core skills and become more confident with Collage in a supportive learning environment.

Students will concentrate on one main project throughout the course and gain an understanding of how to build and layer a collage and apply colour and line to create an affective balance within their work.

Art is a continual learning process and this course would also give previous students the opportunity to progress their skills further, whilst exploring new techniques.

Students' prior learning and their expectations about the course will be assessed by individual student discussions at the start of the course.

**The course will cover:**

- Understanding paper as a palette
- How to apply texture to gain depth
- Learning to see the difference between colour and tone
- Developing skills on how to mix Collage and Paint.
- Using observational skills and working from image reference
- How to create unity between paper and paint

Evaluation of your learning journey will be measured by reviewing the work at the beginning and end of the course.

**By the end of the course students** should feel confident with their progress using a range of collage materials and be able to judge, create and assess accurately.
