Early Applications deadline



Thursday 15th October 2020 - 18:00

Applications for any course at the universities of Oxford and Cambridge, or for most courses in medicine, veterinary medicine/science, and dentistry, should arrive at UCAS by 18:00 (UK time) today to guarantee equal consideration.



Main Applications deadline



Applications for all UCAS Undergraduate courses, except [those with a 15 October deadline](#), should be completed by **9th December 2020**
