UCAS application process timeline and personal statements First Draft – Finalising your personal statement



Early Applications deadline



Thursday 15th October 2020 - 18:00

Applications for any course at the universities of Oxford and Cambridge, or for most courses in medicine, veterinary medicine/science, and dentistry, should arrive at UCAS by 18:00 (UK time) today to guarantee equal consideration.



Main Applications deadline



Applications for all UCAS Undergraduate courses, except those with a 15 October deadline, should be completed by 9th December 2020



Virtual Open Days


- Universities are offering Virtual Open Days this year


How to use the Personal Statement Tool




From the main dashboard, click on the Personal Statement box.









At the top you can see the university subject for which you are writing the Statement. This can be edited by simply clicking on the green text.

The tool splits your Personal Statement into three sections. You can complete these in any order.


At the top of each section you will see some prompts in green text. Each one expands to show an example.

Whatever you type will be automatically saved within this box until you're ready to save it as a new version.


You can save as many versions as you like.

You can send the latest draft of your full Personal Statement to anyone by using this function at the bottom of the page.








You can view your Personal Statement as it will appear on your UCAS form through the UCAS tool, which is accessible from your main dashboard.
