FRIENDS OF SALTERGATE SCHOOLS – CHAIR'S REPORT 2024

What a first year we've had!! It has been a massive learning curve for us all so thank you to all parents/guardians/school staff for the over-whelming support, and patience!

After forming in late April 2023, we had our first committee meeting May 2023 to start looking at what we could do to raise funds, and how we should get going as a PTA.

Our first step was to decide on becoming a 'Friends of...' rather than a classic PTA, as this would allow friends/extended family members to get involved, rather than just parents and teachers. We set up a bank account (not as straight forward as you might think), registered as a charity, set up a Facebook page, reached out for parent/guardian support and started planning our first events.

June 2023

Bake Sale - £341.55

This was so much more successful than we could possibly have imagined! Held on both the infants and junior playgrounds, the weather was in our favor, the donations were incredible, and the turnout was simply brilliant! Thank you to all for the donated bakes and for spending hard earned pennies.

Ice pop sale - £84.47

A bit of a last-minute fund raiser, mainly us wanting to make the most of the weather. A reasonably popular sale and one we will probably do again.

Movie Night – Cancelled

This was really disappointing for us to have to cancel. We had already paid for the movie license, had some great ideas for providing refreshments etc, but due to insufficient ticket sales we could not proceed. If there was likely to be enough interest in the future, we would consider trying again at some point.

July 2023

Summer Fair - £4800.28

I think everyone was blown away by the summer fair. Despite the weather really being against us at first, the numbers that turned up were fantastic! We had a good mix of outside traders, games, tombola's, attractions, an amazing raffle... and we had a huge number of volunteers, including the incredible RAF air cadets, who all enabled us to actually put on the type of fair we really wanted to. This will be a tough act to follow for summer 2024.

End of year BBQ/uniform sales - £219.29

This was our last event of the school year, it was really just for us to use up our leftover stock from the summer fair, but it proved to be more popular than we had expected. Again, the weather stayed on our side, just, and the atmosphere amongst all who attended was really positive. A lovely way to end the school year for summer!

September 2023

Quiz Night – Cancelled

Another disappointment at having to cancel an event. We simply didn't have enough interest in this one. This led to us running a colouring competition for the children on the reverse of a feedback questionnaire, so that we could gather feedback from parents/guardians on what events people would like us to run. Interestingly one of the items we were told people wanted was a Quiz Night!!

October 2023

Bake Sale - £225.25

Due to poor weather we had to move the bake sale into the Children's Centre, and although it wasn't as big a success as the first bake sale, we still took a fantastic amount, so thank you again to all who donated and all who came and supported us.

Autumn Fest - £213.01

We actually took over £600 on this event, but had big outlays for food/drink and supplies. So the overall profit was a little less than we had hoped but the turnout was brilliant and everyone seemed to really enjoy themselves. The pumpkin carving competition was particularly popular!

December

Christmas Fair - £1932.47

My personal favourite, the Christmas fair was a fun afternoon for all. A mix of games, sales, food, tombolas, rainbow raffle and who can forget Buddy the ELF!! Another event that was full of positive feedback afterwards. Huge thanks again to all that helped, from the donations in the run up, to the amazing volunteers on the day. And to Mrs Hall and the school team for the hugely popular Christmas tree lucky dip prizes!

Elfridges - £402.99

Set up in the Children's Centre all the children were invited to come along and purchase a gift for a loved one at a set price of \pounds 2. The Foss team then took the gifts away to be wrapped and then returned to the children for them to give as a Christmas present. All the children seemed to really enjoy their opportunity to come and 'shop' for themselves.

Last Day of Term Sale - £302.01

Another opportunity for us to try and clear some of our leftover stock which proved to be more popular than we had expected. We also sold hotdogs and hot chocolates. Another lovely end to the term.

February 2024
