

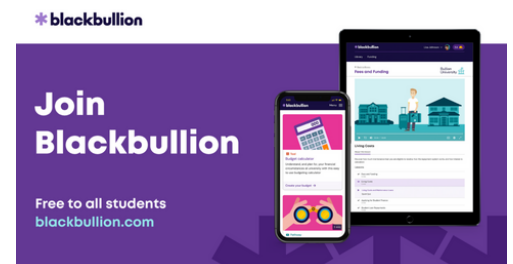
CAREERS BULLETIN

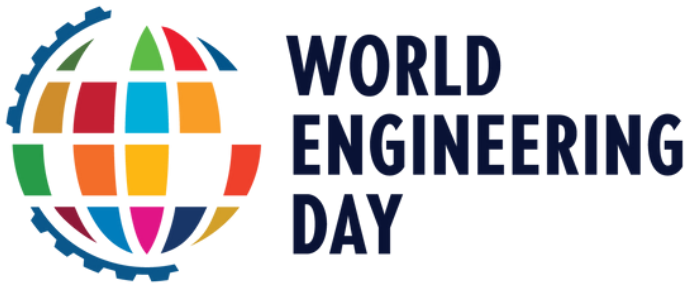
